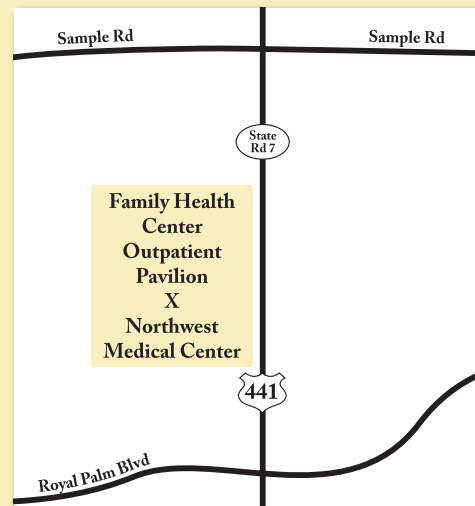


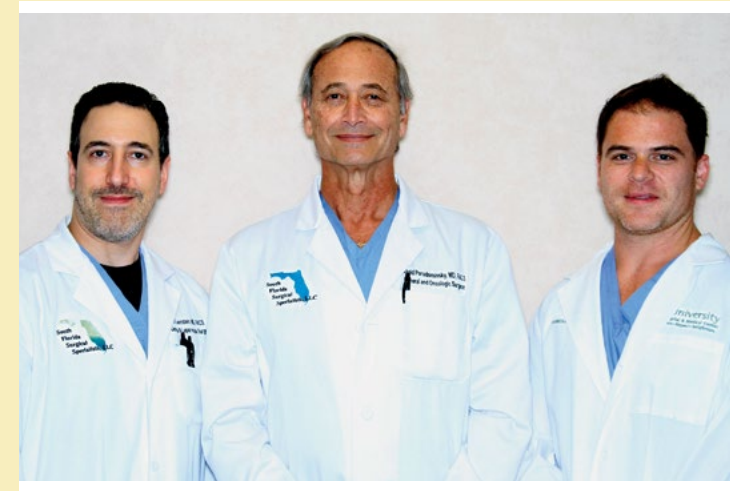
Practice Overview

David Porudominsky, MD, FACS

Dr. David Porudominsky is a General Surgeon and a fellowship trained surgical oncologist. He has been in private practice in this location since 1985. His practice includes thyroid, parathyroid surgery, benign and malignant breast disease, abdominal surgery with minimally invasive laparoscopic techniques including gallbladder, stomach, small and large bowel with special interest in cancer surgery including skin malignancies such as melanoma and soft tissue tumors. He graduated from Cayetano Heredia Medical School in Peru in 1977 and completed a surgical residency at the State University of New York at Stony Brook program in 1982, followed by a fellowship in surgical oncology at the City of Hope National Medical Center. He completed his Board Certification in 1985.

He is a board member of ParkCreek Surgical Center, South Florida Surgical Specialists and Board of Trustees at Northwest Medical Center. He has been Chief of Surgery and Chief of Staff at Northwest for many years and has been a member of the Medical Executive Committee and Board of Trustees.



Eric Kleinstein, MD, FACS

Dr. Eric Kleinstein has been practicing in South Florida since 2001. He moved his practice to Margate in 2003. As a Board-Certified General Surgeon, his expertise and special interests are in Breast Surgery, Laparoscopic Surgery, Thyroid Surgery, Hernia Repairs, Skin Cancers and Wound Care. Dr. Kleinstein has served, or is serving, in multiple leadership roles including Vice Chief of Staff, Chief of Surgery, and Medical Director of the Wound Care Center at University Hospital. He is a Clinical Assistant Professor at Dr. Kiran C. Patel Colleges of Allopathic and Osteopathic Medicine at Nova Southeastern University. He is active in teaching Surgical residents and students.

Dr. Kleinstein attended New York University as an undergraduate. He graduated from UMDNJ - New Jersey Medical School in 1994. He began his residency at Maimonides Medical Center in Brooklyn, NY. After completing a year in research during his residency, he returned to New Jersey Medical School to complete his training. His research has been published in various journals and presented at multiple meetings.



Rafael Sierra, MD, FACS

Dr. Rafael Sierra is a General Surgeon with advanced Laparoscopic, Minimally Invasive and Robotic Surgery Training. He obtained his Medical degree at Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México and did an internship at Tel Aviv University Sheba Medical Center. He spent two years at Tulane University doing research in advanced laparoscopic and robotic surgery. He completed his General Surgery residency at Tulane in 2010.

Since then he has continued to stay at the forefront of advanced minimally invasive surgery, including robotic surgery. In 2011 he was one of the first 200 surgeons trained in robotic single incision cholecystectomy and has performed more than 500 robotic procedures.

Dr. Sierra's goal is to provide his patients with the best available surgical options for their particular problem along with compassionate care.

The surgical office of Dr. Porudominsky, Dr. Kleinstein & Dr. Sierra, MD, FACS was established in 1985 and is a group practice of board certified surgeons specializing in general, oncologic, laparoscopic, robotic and breast surgery.

General Surgery includes a wide range of procedures usually performed in the hospital. Many procedures can be performed without the need for an overnight stay in the hospital. Some of the more common procedures are:

Laparoscopic Appendectomies

Breast Surgery for cancer including in-office needle biopsy, breast conserving lumpectomies and mastectomies.

Laparoscopic and Robotic Colon Surgery for cancer, infection and diverticulitis.

Laparoscopic and Robotic Gallbladder Surgery for gallbladder disease (Cholecystectomy).

Laparoscopic and Robotic Hernia Repairs - Inguinal, ventral, incisional, diaphragmatic, umbilical, and complex hernia repairs using component separation technique.

Skin Cancers including melanoma, basal cell and squamous cell cancers.

Thyroid and Parathyroid Surgery for benign and malignant diseases.

Soft Tissue Tumors including benign and malignant tumors such as sarcomas.

Oncology (Cancer) Surgery includes surgery of the gallbladder, stomach, small and large bowel, thyroid, breast and intra-abdominal malignancy. It also includes soft skin and soft tissue tumors.
